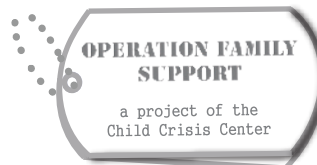
- Knowledge of life cycle spirituality issues experienced by military and veteran families.
